

# Mid America Pop Warner Certification Book Instructions

1/23/11

- 1) **Pop Warner Roster:** Placed in the first page of the certification book. Front one side, back the other.( The participants files must be in Roster Order)
- 2) **Coach's Certificate-** Placed in the second sleeve of the Certification Book

## Child's Packet:

- 3) **Birth Certificate:** Must be certified with the state or a Pass port.( No Hospital Birth Certificate excepted)
- 4) **National Pop Warner Medical( Physical) form:** 2 sided form, must be dated and signed by the Parents and Doctor.
- 5) **National Pop Warner Parent consent Form and Contract Form:** All forms must be filled out and signed by the Parent and child.
- 6) **Report Card:** Must be the final report card showing the final grade or all semester grades. Contact Patti Kirkwood on any questions regarding report cards.
- 7) **National Pop Warner Scholastic Eligibility Form:** This form is to be completed by those participants in the Pop Warner program that have not met the National Scholastic requirement of 70% and /or 2.0 GPA . This form must be accompanied by a satisfactory progress report or report card passing 51% of their subjects to be eligible for play. The report must be dated between the dates shown on the eligibility form to be eligible for the rest of the year including competition or playoffs.

The Head Coach is responsible for their teams Certification book.

Each Association must highlight the designated points on each document Specified by the region.

ID cards must accompany the certification book to all practices and games.

All forms mentioned above must be collected from each child before the said child can start practice.

All Players **MUST** attend the leagues weigh ins on the date assigned by the Region. Any player not present at the official weigh in, must be weighed in at an emergency weigh in scheduled after the first regular season game by the League. Any player missing the official weigh in **IS NOT** eligible for the first game.
